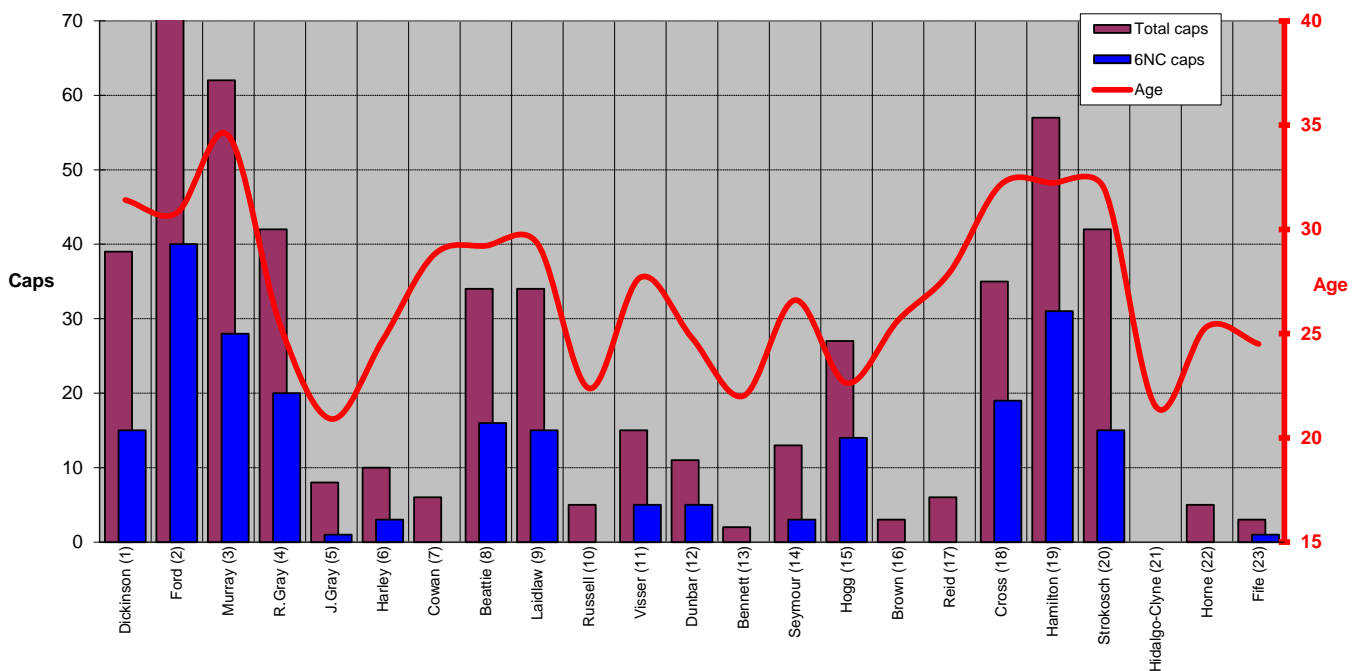


OFFICIAL RBS 6 NATIONS TEAM SELECTION DELIVERED BY ACCENTURE
SCOTLAND v FRANCE at Stade de France, 7.2.2015 (18:00 local time)

Head coach Vern Cotter hands RBS 6 Nations debuts to three of his starting lineup, with flanker **Blair Cowan**, stand-off **Finn Russell** and centre **Mark Bennett** all making first starts in rugby's greatest championship. Included on the bench is uncapped 21-year-old scrum-half **Sam Hidalgo-Clyne**, and three others new to the RBS 6 Nations: hooker **Fraser Brown**, prop **Gordon Reid** and centre **Peter Horne**. Brothers **Richie & Jonny Gray** become the third set of siblings to start a championship match after the Spanghero's in 1971 and the Llewellyn's in 1991.

The XV has 388 test caps between them; the bench has a further 151 caps.

The average age of the walk-on team is 26.7 years; the average on the bench is 27.7

Made senior Scotland debut in the RWC2007 match against New Zealand at BT Murrayfield less than two weeks after he had been called into the squad. Also played for Scotland in RWC2011 after which he was not selected for 20 months

Appeared in 4 rounds of the RBS 6 Nations last season, but has not started for Scotland in rugby's greatest tournament since 2010

Both of his test tries have come at BT Murrayfield against Italy in August 2011 and Japan in November 2013. Has started Scotland's last 5 test matches in the No. 1 shirt

Started the last three rounds of the 2014 RBS 6 Nations having been a replacement against Ireland in round 1.
