WALES v ENGLAND at Millennium Stadium, 6.2.2015 (20:05)

Head coach Warren Gatland hands out an RBS 6 Nations debut to 22-year-old Scarlets tighthead prop **Samson Lee**, whilst fellow front-rowers **Scott Baldwin** and **Aaron Jarvis** will also make their bows in the tournament should they come off the bench.

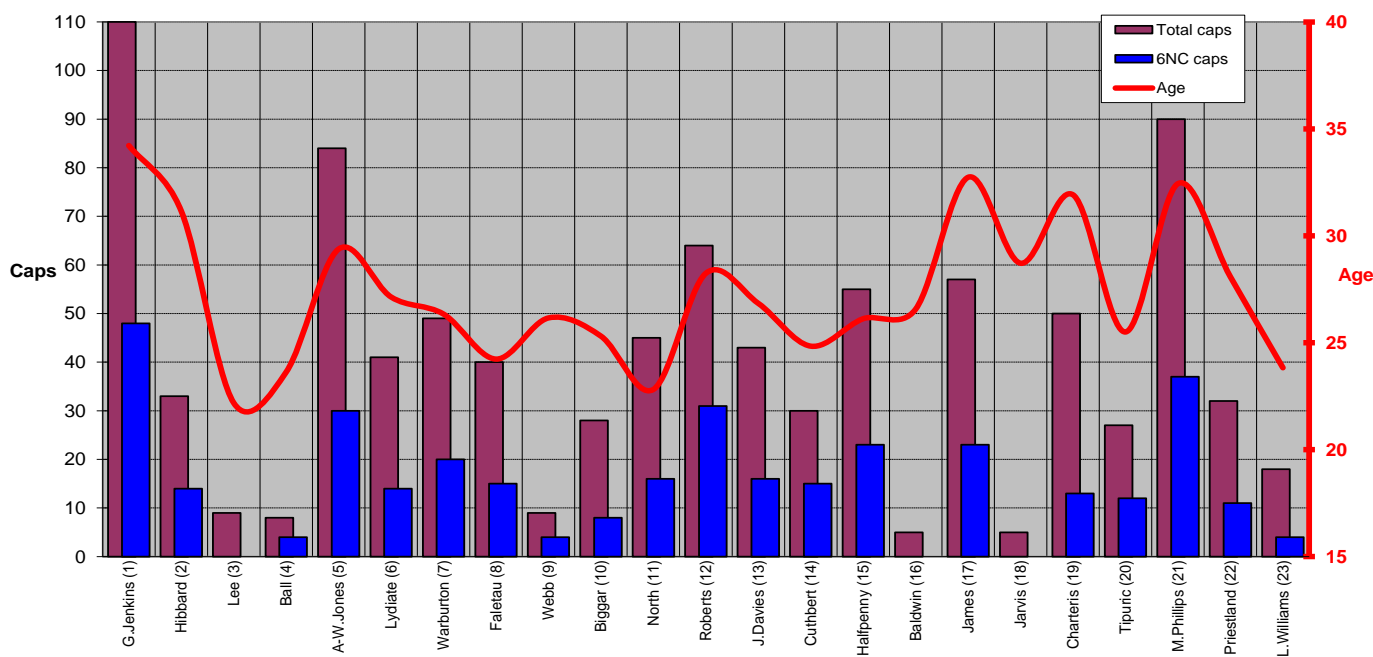
Sam Warburton leads Wales for the 31st time and becomes the 35th player and the seventh youngest to gain 50 caps for Wales.

The XV has 648 test caps between them; the bench has a further 284 caps.

The half-back combination of **Rhys Webb** and **Dan Biggar** account for just 6% of the starting caps.

The average age of the walk-on team is 27.5 years; the average on the bench is 27.3

Played in two British & Irish Lions tours: to New Zealand in 2005 and South Africa in 2009 playing in five tests. Selected for a third tour in 2013 but injury prevented him from playing.

Scored his only RBS 6 Nations try to date in the grand slam deciding game against Ireland in Cardiff in 2005. Scored his 4th test try in his 78th cap against Namibia during RWC2011 and has not crossed since.

Only one player has appeared in more RBS 6 Nations games for Wales - Stephen Jones with 50.
