DID YOU KNOW...

French coach Marc Lievreumont's bold decision to drop six senior players from the 22 that lost to Italy in Rome last weekend has taken 379 caps worth of experience out of his side. Between them Aurelien Rougerie (63 caps), Yannick Jauzion (73), Sylvain Marconnet (83), Sebastien Chabal (62), Jerome Thion (54) and Clement Poitrenaud (44). Between them the six players have won eight Grand Slams and 18 Six Nations titles. Wales outside half James Hook will be looking to maintain his 100% record in the RBS 6 Nations in the No 10 jersey. Last weekend's victory over Ireland was his seventh Championship start in the legendary Welsh shirt and all seven matches have been won. He has also come onto the field four times to take over at No 10 and won three of them.
